



 - Access local business support for emerging and small businesses





















Where are we now

- ± 13000 users. Growth rate at 100 new users per month
- Aim is to have 100 communities connected by the end of the year
- Access to relevant local content key to a successful e-government programme
- Mobile Smart Cape based on Brazilian Mobile SAC









Building a Smart City: Enhancing our IT Skill Base



Currently have 130 youth in the programme

- Critical to the success of the project is the mentor/assessor role, and the City has invested in building this capability.
- Interns have access to both theoretical and practical knowledge thus preparing them for employment upon completion of their year-long learnership
 - experience in a large complex organisation utilising the latest technologies (SAP, Microsoft Server 2003, Active Directory, dotNet development environment, C#, etc.)
- Project is an enabler of social and economic development
- The challenges of expanding this project would be dependent on the success of the evaluation and the extent to which the ICT industry is prepared to partner with us.
