Issue 1 - 2

Political issues of our society

Analysis:

- Corruption, Human rights and Underdevelopment
- Unemployment, Money / Income and Discrimination
- Justice and Law Enforcement
- Health and Education

Suggestions:

- Affirmative policy should be strengthened, not to reinforce marginalization of minority groups, but to elevate them to higher income brackets.
- Transparency in institutions such as government, judicial system and law enforcement, must enable individuals to question irregular practices by the above institutions. Implementation of evaluation processes to promote constructive change.
- Governments should establish a commitment to protect and respect traditional democratic decision making processes.

Analysis:

- Transportation
- Drugs
- Poverty
- Ignorance, Racism
- Child Trafficking

Suggestions:

- Solve conflicts early with respective government partners in order to construct healthy relationships for better governance of states and citizenry.
- Do more empathic work. Talk less and listen more through non-bias facilitated discussion.
- Use best practices from countries with similar economic and social capabilities in order to improve problematic aspects of each state.

Issue 1 - 2

Urban environment

citizens planning and living in a city

Analysis:

- Urban planning does not effectively involve citizens and thus cannot meet their needs.
- Inaccessibility of important areas of our cities due to increased privatization of public space and insufficient public transit, which limits access.

Suggestions:

- Recognizing that current urban planning practices do not usefully consult citizens and actively working to make consultation effective through stronger legislation.
- Investigate strategies for reclaiming the redundant parts of cities, e.g. roads and rivers.
- Recognizing that architecture must be understandable to the general public, i.e. drawing the elitist visual sensibilities of architects closer to the sensibilities of citizens.

Issue 2 - 2

Space for youth and children

physical space and accessibility of the city

Analysis:

- Lack of green playing spaces for children
- Cities are not yet open to youth:
 - youth are stigmatized in public space
 - the cities do not offer locales that are youth-friendly
 - insufficient social and cultural institutions for youth

Suggestions:

- Requiring private development to devote funds to surrounding public spaces, especially green spaces.
- Diversity is the key to making cities accessible to youth; government support for ethnic and cultural communities will help open them up to youth and the entire city.
- Promote urban culture by relocating institutions, which youth depend upon, in the downtown core.

- Improve mobility at night

Issue 2 - 2

Unsustainability

of urban transport

Analysis:

- Too many cars, traffic jams
- Pollution

Suggestions:

- Promote cycling and walking
- Improve transport education
- More developed subway systems
- Construction of more parking sites on the edges of the dense areas, linked with public transportation system
- Car free days
- Research and promote ecological fuels (water engines, biological petrol, solar cars, hydrogen)

Main Problems:

- Water, waste and bad quality
- Air Pollution
- Education problems, lack of awareness

Analysis:

- People are demotivated because of the big dimension of the problem
- Irresponsibility

Suggestions:

- Minding the international problems all youth brought to the workshop
- Trying to create a new urban space
 - There are circulation spaces and meeting points that improve life quality
- Positive impulse school: to make students maintain our environment, to make them feel included in projects that positively change the city
- Examples:
 - International youth exchange, school gardens, creative city subjects, no waste policy
- Construction of new water pumps in order to provide drinkable water
